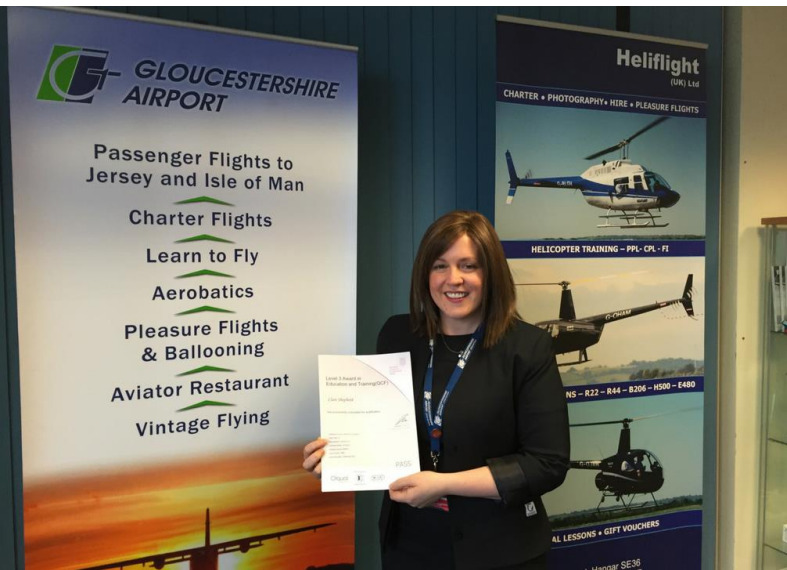


CASE STUDY
